

Privacy policy

KNOWCO (KNOWCO B.V.) takes your privacy very seriously and ensuring a secure environment when using and handling personal data is one of our main priorities in designing and building our systems. By using any website of KNOWCO and agreeing to the terms & conditions you declare that you have read our Privacy Policy and you agree to be bound by it. Conversely, if you do not agree with any aspect of this Privacy Policy then you also agree not to register for an account with KNOWCO or on any of its affiliated websites.

Information Collection and Processing

KNOWCO collects personal information of Users only as necessary for supplying its services. KNOWCO may use external providers – such as server providers, email services, file storage services, etc. – which will process your personal information as necessary for supplying KNOWCO services. Any User is aware that these suppliers may be held to comply with data protection legislation in their respective jurisdiction of operation, and any User gives permission for the processing of data under the laws of any such jurisdiction. KNOWCO uses your personal information exclusively in compliance with this Privacy Policy.

Sharing information and publication

KNOWCO will not sell your personal information, rent it, or otherwise make it available to anyone except with your prior and unequivocal consent; or whenever it is necessary to meet a legal requirement; or when it is necessary for carrying out a KNOWCO service.

If you chose to gain access to KNOWCO via a personal account on another site – LinkedIn, Twitter, Facebook or Google – you are giving permission to KNOWCO to allow access to KNOWCO through Open authorization (oAuth). KNOWCO is not in any way responsible for the data handling by such a third party.

The KNOWCO social network has limited features that allow Users to get in contact with each other, or share information about their activities or preferences. By default these functionalities are highly limited. Via the settings menus the User can adjust these functionalities further.

Cookie Policy

KNOWCO uses Cookies where necessary to collect information about the use of the website and improve ease of use. Sometimes KNOWCO will also use Cookies from third parties such as social networking sites or analytic sites. Any User can adjust their software in such a way as to prevent cookies from being installed.

Changes

KNOWCO reserves the right to change the Privacy Policy unilaterally. If changes have a significant impact on the nature of the handling of the User's personal information then KNOWCO will notify the User by placing a prominent warning on the website or an equivalent form of clear notification.

Contact & General
